### Like A River Glorious

Two common images that depict peace and freedom from worry are a meadow under a blue sky with a river running through it, or a child clasped in his parent's arms. This hymn employs both pictures to portray the peace of God. Its central message is that when one rests in God, and receives His peace, there is nothing in the world worth worrying about.

Frances Havergal wrote this hymn while she was living at Leamington, England, in 1874. This peaceful, simple tune makes use of frequent repetition of notes and phrases which makes a good tune for congregations to sing, but the tempo should not rush, or the tranquility of the text and tune is lost.

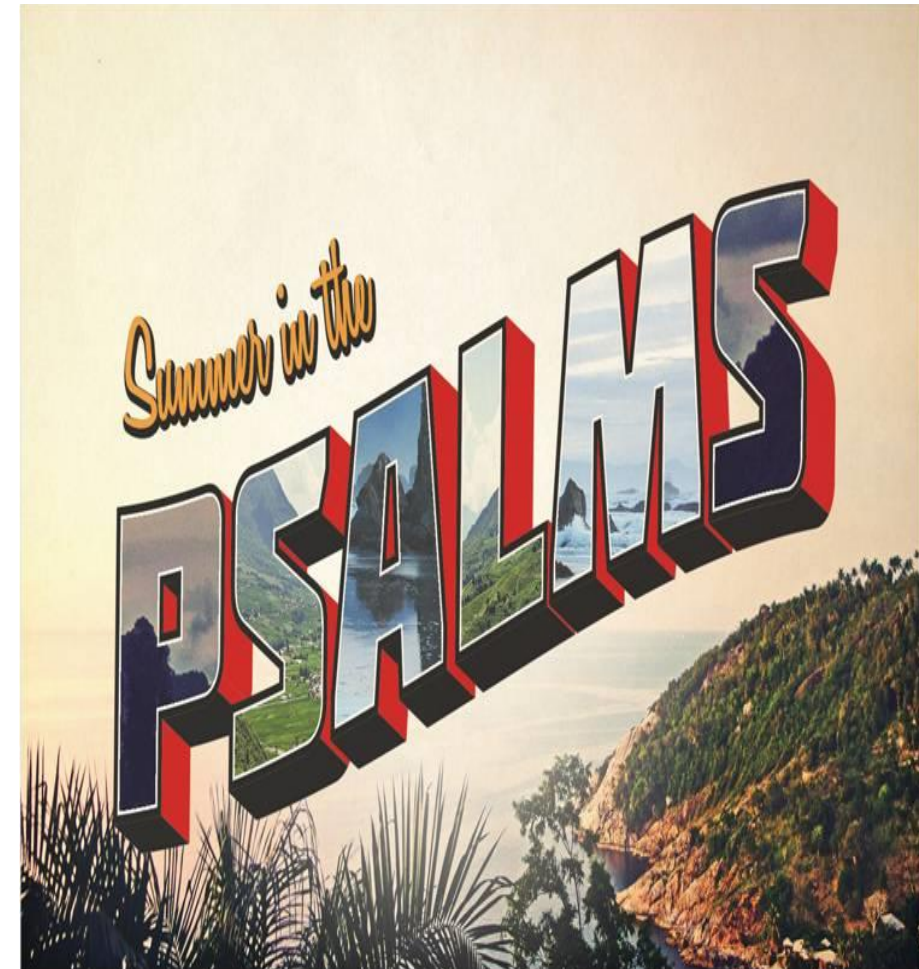
